SISTER MARY WILL BE A SAINT

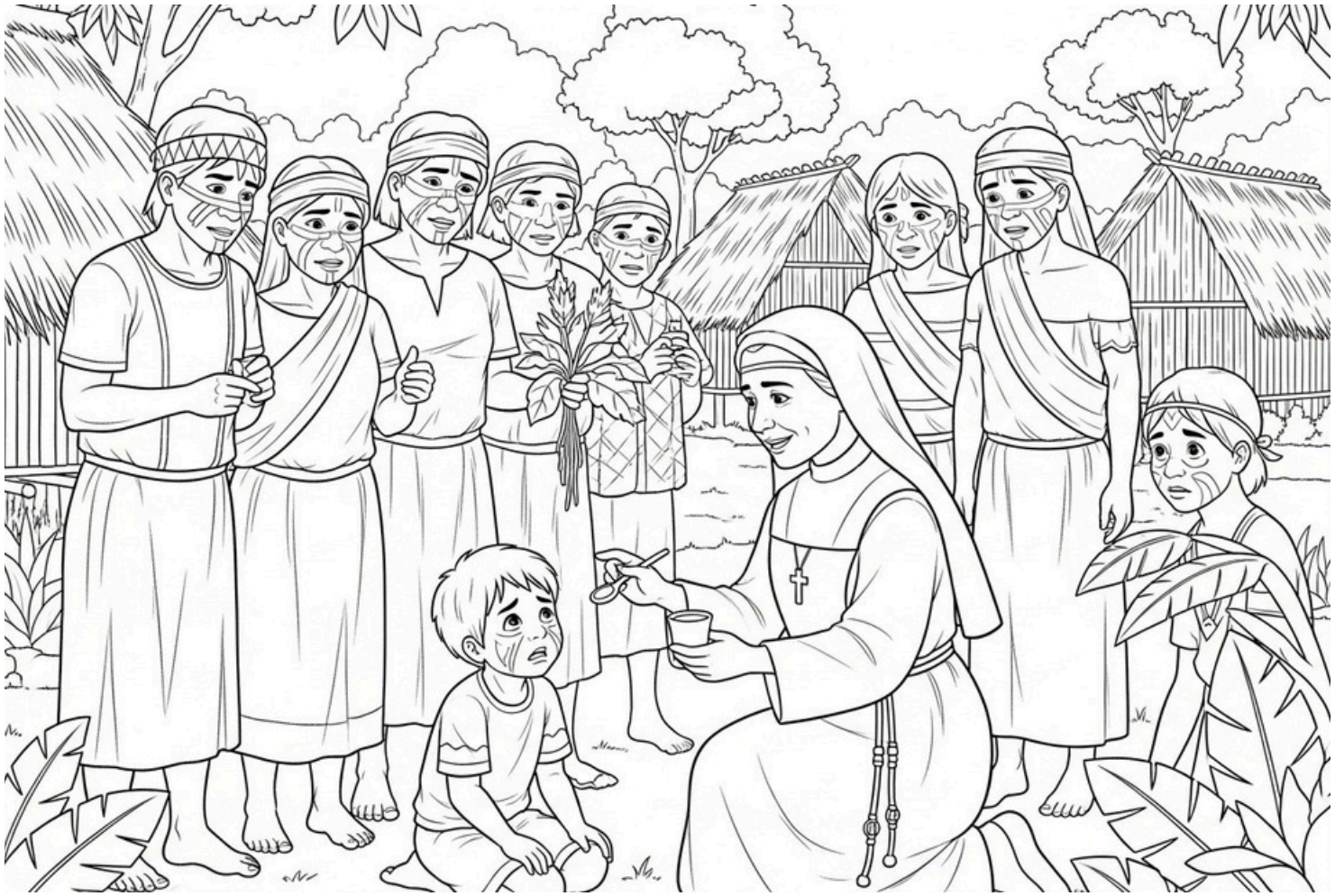
Sister María taught us that the greatest love is to serve with joy. She is now in heaven and is our friend forever.
